Happy New Year to the Friends of the Arroyo Grande Library! We hope that your new year has gotten off to as great a start as ours has.

The Arroyo Grande Library is pleased to announce the launch of the County of San Luis Obispo Public Library's new library app, myLIBRO. myLIBRO is our library catalog mobile app. Download myLIBRO to your device for a convenient way to search the catalog, place holds, and view your library card and account activity. To get started with myLIBRO just:

- 1. Visit your favorite app store and download myLIBRO
- 2. Search for County of San Luis Obispo Public Libraries
- 3. Sign in with your library card number and password

You'll need your library card number and the password you usually use to sign into your library account online. To search for books on the myLIBRO app's home screen, tap the search icon. Then select your library from the dropdown menu at the top of the Search screen. You can also set your search preference to All Branches to search the entire catalog. If you can't find what you want, try searching our entire catalog by selecting All Branches from the dropdown menu at the top of the Search screen.

myLIBRO is an easy way to create a digital library card, place holds, get book recommendations, view library events and social media, and check your library account. Feel free to share any feedback or questions about myLIBRO with us at the Refence Desk. We hope you enjoy using the myLIBRO app.

Arroyo Grande Library will be hosting yoga for adults on our back lawn on Thursdays at 2:30 in February. On February 25th at 2PM the SLO Symphony Musical Petting Zoo will be dropping by to share instruments for all to try. All of our March programs will focus on our upcoming Book of the Year partnership with Cuesta College, focusing on the book **All My Rage** by Sabaa Tahir. The art cart has rotating crafts and supplies so that it stays exciting and inspiring. Here are some quotes from parents whose children used the art cart: "I love that creativity is encouraged." The Read to a Dog program is another success. We have several calm registered therapy dogs with encouraging handlers who come on a rotating schedule every Wednesday at 3:30. Children come in to read to the dog as well to be introduced to dogs if they don't have one in their lives. One little boy comes because he really wants a dog but can't have one at home. It is a joy to see the dogs interact with their "clients."

The SLO Symphony will be at the Arroyo Grande Library on February 25 at 2:00 to present their Instrument Petting Zoo. They will learn about the different types of instruments, how each one creates a unique sound, and how they are played. Each instrument is carefully cleaned in between each use.

Five Cities Fire Authority will come to two of our storytimes in February. They will read stories, show the kids their fire fighting gear and offer a tour of their truck. They do a really nice job with the kids. Fire Fighter Storytime will be on February 8 and 9 at 10:30.

They provide the words and music to go with classics like This Land is Your Land, Aiken Drum and other favorites. If you enjoy singing feel free to stop by sometime.
